Free Trade Agreements delivering for local businesses in Reid

In a visit to Sydney today the Minister for Trade and Investment, Steven Ciobo joined the Federal Member for Reid Craig Laundy, to meet with local business owners who are benefiting from the recently signed trade agreements.

Mr Ciobo said the Turnbull Government's ambitious trade agenda will drive job creation and economic growth in Reid.

"The Coalition Government has already delivered export trade agreements with three of our largest trading partners - China, Japan and Korea - delivering thousands of jobs and growth opportunities for small businesses in Reid," he said.

"A re-elected Turnbull Government will pursue new free trade agreements to create more local jobs and attract new investment for Reid."

As a result of the Coalitions trade initiatives, Australia's economy is projected to be more than \$24 billion larger by 2035.

Mr Laundy said the new and existing agreements form a vital part of our National Economic Plan.

"Today we've seen and heard from local business owners who are already benefiting from the Turnbull Government's trade agenda," he said.

"We spoke with entrepreneurial local business people who are exporting wine, meat products, logistics and e-commerce services to China, and heard how the China-Australia FTA has boosted their business success"

"A re-elected Turnbull Government will continue to deliver even more opportunities for local businesses with our ambitious trade agenda," Mr Laundy said.
