TURNBULL GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCES FUNDING FOR CENTENARY PARK UPGRADE

The Member for Reid, Craig Laundy, was pleased to announce today that a re-elected Turnbull Government will contribute \$1.3 million towards ground improvements at Centenary Park, Croydon.

Centenary Park is the home ground for Burwood Football Club, Ashfield Cricket Club and is used by the general community as an important local playing field.

This funding contribution complements a previous state government commitment of \$500,000 and will allow works to commence on the \$1.8 million upgrade.

The works to be undertaken will include new amenities, meeting rooms, new sports field lighting, security lighting and fencing.

Craig Laundy said the Government's investment in Centenary Park will end once and for all the frustration that the users of the park have had.

"The proposed works have long been sought by Burwood FC and other users of the park and I am delighted that a re-elected Turnbull government will help establish a local sporting facility of world class standards."

"The proposed works will allow existing users of the park to enjoy some outstanding facilities whilst ensuring that the amenity of nearby residents is protected."

"We have a fantastic local sporting tradition in the inner west and I'm proud to be delivering a commitment to strengthen that," Mr Laundy said.

By investing in much needed community infrastructure like the Centenary Park upgrade, a re-elected Turnbull Government will deliver jobs, growth and stronger communities.
