TURNBULL GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCES FUNDING FOR WANGAL PARK UPGRADE

The Member for Reid, Craig Laundy, has today announced that a re-elected Turnbull Government will provide \$1 million in funding for substantial improvements to Wangal Park in Croydon.

The recently completed wetland ponds of Wangal Park serve as a much-needed habitat for local flora and fauna, with the Park spanning 4.2 hectares of dedicated greenspace. Together with funding from Burwood Council, the Turnbull Government's additional contribution will allow the Park to expand its amenities to include shared pathways for pedestrians and bicycles, and playgrounds and sporting equipment.

Craig Laundy said that Wangal Park provides valuable greenspace, but noted that it required further financial support to allow the community to make the best use of the area.

"A re-elected Turnbull Government will contribute to Wangal Park to ensure that this great community facility will be able to reach its full potential, including the construction of playgrounds, a half basketball court and skate park alongside the wetland ponds and park area for the community," Mr Laundy said.

"I'm proud to support these upgrades to Wangal Park which will provide our community with a greenspace area that has outstanding recreational facilities for generations."

Mr Laundy said the funding will also go towards the construction of picnic shelters and barbecues in locations throughout the Park.

"Our area is community-focused, active and welcoming, so I'm delighted to be able to support these recreational facilities in Wangal Park for residents and visitors to enjoy."

Through investments like the Wangal Park upgrade, a re-elected Turnbull Government is committed to delivering jobs, growth and strengthening our communities.
